How will the selection process work?

The candidates will be chosen by August 15th, 2022 through a formal review process headed by our President, Salvatore Cimmino, and representative from the Korean Society based on the following considerations;

- The pertinence of the area of expertise
- The candidate experience in the field of AI or IoT (AIoT)
- The expertise they can bring as part of this World Fair
- Their English or Korean Fluency

AIoT Canada's ecosystem and visibility members will be given priority in the selection process.

All selected members must have filled their profile on: connect.aiotcanada.ca at the time of submission. This portal will be used for matchmaking purposes. AIoT Canada wishes that all participants of the matchmaking session be fully recognizable (i.e., picture). Profile will be helpful for our staff in optimizing the matchmakings.
